Here's how you can help:



Lookup which restaurants are doing takeout or curbside delivery.

If they're not on the listings, be sure to give them a call, and see if they're still open. They may not have added themselves to the we're still open resources.

Order from restaurants directly by calling or using their website

Did you know that when you order food from a delivery service, a big chunk of the profits restaurants would receive gets taken? Order directly from restaurants by phone, or online, and give the 'delivery fee' you would've paid as a tip! Putting money back into the pockets of restaurant workers is a great way to keep your favorite places open when things return to normal.

TIP #1: Purchase a restaurant gift card

Help restaurants get a quick flow of cash by purchasing a gift card.

TIP #2: Show some love and tip a little extra

Your little extra means a whole lot to those who prepare your food.



Share photos on social of your meal. Use the hashtag #turnthetablesmn

Sharing photos of the meals you ordered for takeout on social helps give this program momentum. It gets the word out to your social network and gives a rallying cry to help Minnesota's restaurants stay afloat.


